

Customers get clean, green power for a low monthly fee




PG&E's Tiered Pricing



North America Solar Incentives

- Rebates California Solar Incentive (CSI)
- Income Tax Credits federal 30% ITC
- Feed in Tariffs (Gainesboro FL, Vermont, Ontario) – usually oversubscribed
- Local Government extra payments on property taxes (Berkeley, Sonoma County, Boulder County – around 7% interest rate)
- Renewable Portfolio Standards (RPS) Large Scale only

How close are we to Grid Parity now? May 2009 unsubsidised Local Power c/kWh ○3kW system – 26.6c/kWh ○ July 2009 - tariff 11 - residential is 18.84c/kWh April 2010 - 3kW PV system - 19.9c/kWh OAssumptions in model haven't changed 3kW PV system fully installed 4.2kWh / kW generation per day in Brisbane then 1% panel performance degradation each year PV component lifetime of 30 years (panels, rails, cables) Inverter has 10 year life (extended warranty) Replace inverter after year 10 & year 20 July 2010 – tariff 11 very likely 20c+/kWh
